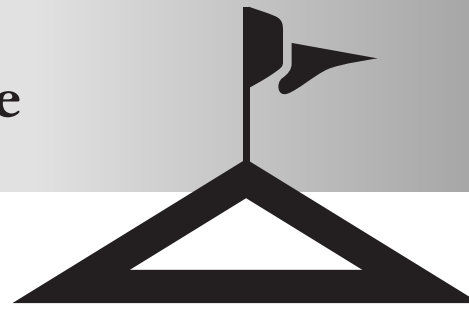

# COLLEGE FOR KIDS



College for Kids (CFK) is a summer program offered by the Community Learning department of Lincoln Land Community College. The goals of CFK are to develop and expand students' interests, stimulate creativity, and provide unique learning opportunities on a college campus. College for Kids classes are held on LLCC's main campus, utilizing our beautiful outdoor spaces as well as our classrooms and computer labs.

Class offerings are for students who have completed first through eighth grades as of spring 2010. Four weeklong sessions are being offered. (Session 4 is for 6th-8th grade students only, with the exception of Kids in the Kitchen for grades 4-7.) Classes in a variety of subject areas are held Monday

through Thursday from 9 a.m. to 12:30 p.m. Students choose three classes to attend throughout the weeklong session and may register for more than one session. (New class selections must be made for each additional week.) Cost for each weeklong session is \$97.

**Session 4: July 26-29 (6th-8th grades only)**
