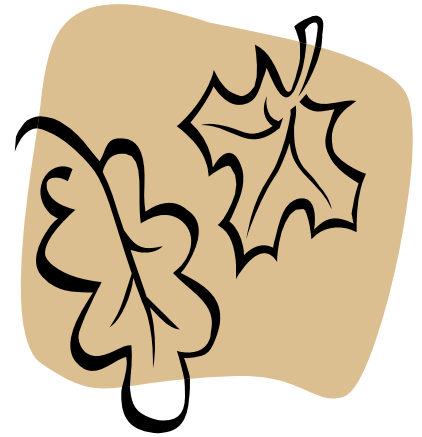

**Advanced RTI Implementation: Strengthening and Sustaining Your Model**

Dr. Batsche is Professor and Co-Director of the Institute for School Reform at the University of South Florida. He is Co-Director of the Florida Statewide Problem-Solving/Response to Intervention Project for the Florida Department of Education. In addition, Dr. Batsche co-directs the Student Support Services, Shared Services Network and Coordinated Student Health Projects for the Florida Department of Education. Dr. Batsche is a nationally known speaker in the area of Response to Intervention and has worked as a mentor for the Illinois ASPIRE project since it began in 2005. Dr. Batsche will focus his presentation on how to strengthen your RTI infrastructure, maintaining intervention integrity, and how to sustain your RTI model.
