## June 30, 2010 Renewal Information for Teachers



**It's hard to believe right now, but spring is on the way. At some point we will quit having snow and cold and the flowers will bloom. Spring means it is time to make sure your certificate is in order for the coming school year. It's a good idea to try to get this covered prior to your summer vacation.**

Registration forms have been mailed to all the public schools in Sangamon County. If your standard certificate is due, you may renew now. The advantage of renewing early is that any professional development you do after April 1st may roll over to the next renewal in 2015. For example, if you are in a spring course and it ends in May OR you have a student teacher in the spring, you will be able to ROLL OVER CPDU's for the next cycle—ONLY if you complete the renewal process including paying your \$25.00 early.

If you have a Standard teaching certificate, the following table pertains to you:

Situation	CPDU's for Five Years Full Time	CPDU's per semester
No advanced degree	120 CPDU's	12 CPDU's
One advanced degree	80 CPDU's	8 CPDU's
More than one advanced degree	40 CPDU's	4 CPDU's
Master teaching certificate	40 CPDU's over ten years	2 CPDU's

Initial certificate holders who are completing their fourth year of teaching in a public or private school may view an instructional video on initial to standard procedures at [www.roe51.org](http://www.roe51.org). It is a good idea to have your paperwork in the Regional Office of Education at 200 S. 9th Street – Room 303 in Springfield, IL 62701 no later than August 1st. Those who complete their work at a later time cannot be promised that their certificate will be valid come the beginning of next school year.

# PBIS Alternative Schools Forum



Sangamon County Learning Academy Principal, Liz Bretz, and Partners in Education Teacher, Heather Crawford, were presenters at the PBIS Alternative Schools Forum in Bloomington, Illinois on February 4, 2010. As the PBIS external and internal coaches for the programs, Mrs. Bretz and Ms. Crawford gave a PowerPoint Presentation on *Teaching Behavior Expectations* which included such things as the PBIS kickoff, cool tools, acknowledgements and staff involvement. The pair also presented a PowerPoint presentation on *Data Collection*. The purpose of the presentation was to discuss the role of discipline data collection in PBIS and to demonstrate how the PBIS team uses the data from *School Wide Information System (SWIS)* to drive decisions on PBIS needs and interventions.

SCLA and PEP have been PBIS schools since January of 2009. They received recognition at the 2009 PBIS Summer Leadership Conference for being an Emerging PBIS School. Mrs. Bretz and Ms. Crawford will be presenting *Using PBIS in the Alternative Setting* at the Illinois Coalition for Educating At-Risk Youth Annual Conference in March.

## Illinois Educator Identification Number (IEIN)

In order to protect your identity, all certificated educators have been assigned an IEIN by the Illinois State Board of Education. ISBE started the process of assigning IEINs two years ago. To locate your assigned IEIN, log into your personal Educators' Certification System (ECS) account. Your personal IEIN will be in the top left hand corner of every page of your ECS account. The advantage to having an IEIN is that your personal number can be used in place of your Social Security Number.

## Administrators 2010 Recertification

Administrators whose Type 75 certificate is up for renewal in the 2010 fiscal year are reminded of the

following:

- Once Professional Development activity hours are recorded in your personal ECS (Educators Certification System) account, and the required Academies are completed for all years in the cycle, and prior to June 30, 2010, **you must submit your Statement of Assurance (SOA)** by clicking on "Statement of Assurance" and clicking through the submission steps on ECS. Check back on ECS under **Statement of Assurance** to determine when your SOA has been approved or if it has been returned to you for correction. The system **does not** notify you by email when your Statement of Assurance is accepted or returned to you. Look for YES/YES under ROE and ISBE/STCB on Statement of Assurance or Register/Renew.
- Once all requirements are met and ROE 51 and ISBE/State Teacher Certification Board (STCB) have approved your Statement of Assurance, you can complete your renewal by paying your registration



fees. This is easily accomplished on ECS under “Register Certificates”. The online renewal fee is \$26.75, using a credit card. If you do not wish to enter a credit card online, the renewal fee is \$25 by paying in person in our downtown office located in the Sangamon County Complex or by mail (with your registration form). You will not be issued a new certificate when your renewal is completed. Your certificate’s registration period can be accessed on ECS at any time.

**Audits – Retain your documentation for each recorded activity for the next 5 year validity period.**

ISBE runs a random audit of Administrator Certificate Renewals through the Regional Office of Education. If your renewal is audited, you will be required to submit documentation for all listed activities to the ROE in order to continue using your administrative certificate.

### **Educators’ Certification System (ECS) for Administrators’ Workshop/Training**

The Regional Office of Education is continuing to offer workshops for administrators on the Educators’ Certification System (ECS) at the Staff Development Center. This ECS Administrators’ Workshop will help participants to better understand recertification requirements and help participants to be more accurate and confident when entering Continuing Professional Development (CPD) activities into the system. This is an ideal workshop for new administrators and an excellent refresher workshop for seasoned administrators.

ECS Training for Administrators will be offered at the Staff Development Center (Computer Lab) on the following dates:

**March 2, 2010 (4:00 p.m. – 6:00 p.m.)**

**April 13, 2010 (4:00 p.m. – 6:00 p.m.)**

For the training it would be helpful if you know your “log-in/account I.D. and password”. Also, please bring your professional development documentation or a list of professional development activities you have participated in.**

### **Administrators Academy Courses for CPDs**

Administrators taking additional Administrators’ Academy courses during a fiscal year will be granted Continuing Professional Development (CPD) credit. For auditing purposes, you do not need to save any evidence documents to indicate that you have taken an Academy course, whether it is your yearly required course or extra courses for CPD credit. Our Regional Office of Education, or the entity that provides the course, will automatically log the evidence into the ISBE data bank.

If you take more than one Academy course in a fiscal year, the course that has the most hours will automatically be recorded as Academy CPD credit.

**Example:** if you take an Academy course that is 6 hours in length and you take a 2-day Academy course for 12 hours in the same fiscal year, regardless of the order in which you took the courses, the 12-hour course will be logged in as Academy CPD credit and the 6-hour course will be logged in as your required course.

ROE 51 encourages you to take advantage of the Academy courses that are offered at the Staff Development.
